

Paying from outside the US

Bryn Mawr has partnered with peerTransfer Education in an effort to make international payments simple and more affordable to International students. peerTransfer's mission is to save International students and their family's money that may otherwise be spent on bank fees or unfavorable foreign exchange currency conversions. By paying in their home currency, students could save up to \$1,500 for a \$40,000 tuition payment compared to using traditional banks. In addition, the posting of the payment to your student account will be faster and more efficient. There is no financial benefit to Bryn Mawr College if you choose to utilize this payment option.

- To get started, select Bryn Mawr as the School you want to pay to
- Select the country from where funds will be coming from and the payment amount in US dollars you wish to make to your student account
- In most cases, the US dollar amount will be converted into your home currency at preferential exchange rates which will translate into a savings for you.
- After providing some additional basic information you will be able to record the transaction and will be instructed via email on how to pay peerTransfer Education from your home country bank account.
- peerTransfer Education will then forward the US dollar amount to Bryn Mawr College where it will be directly credited to your student account.
- You will receive an email to confirm receipt of payment
- At any time, you will have a dedicated customer service team reachable via chat, Skype, email and phone to answer your questions
