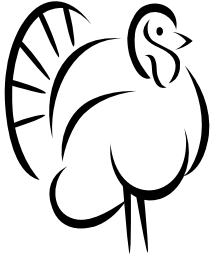

RESIDENCE HALLS

WINTER BREAK PREVIEW

All Bryn Mawr residence halls (excluding Mermont Plaza) close Saturday, December 20 at 10am for Winter Break. Exam period ends December 19 at noon. One card access to dorms will be terminated at 10am on Saturday, December 20. No student may have access to the halls for any reason during Winter Break.

Residence halls reopen Friday, January 16 at noon.

The meal plan resumes Sunday, January 18 with dinner.

A LIMITED AMOUNT OF WINTER BREAK HOUSING IS AVAILABLE FOR A FEE TO THE FOLLOWING STUDENTS ONLY:

- ◆ International students
- ◆ Students with classes in progress at Penn
- ◆ Students participating in college athletics*
- ◆ Special circumstances – requires approval of student's Dean

Merion is the designated Winter Break dorm. Eligible students desiring Winter Break housing must **complete a Winter Break housing form**, available in the Residential Life Office. Athletes will receive separate forms from their coaches. **The deadline for submitting Winter break housing forms is Monday, December 8 at 5pm.** Students who submit late forms are not guaranteed housing. Keys will be distributed on Tuesday, Dec. 16 10am – 4pm in the Campus Center.

Any student with travel plans requiring her to remain on campus the night of Saturday, December 20 only must also complete a Winter Break housing form. Housing for this night will be in Merion and provided on a first come – first served basis. Students will not be permitted to stay in their own rooms.
